

14th Annual of JOSEF MUZIKA VIOLIN COMPETITION
(Saturday 24th of April - Sunday 25th of April 2010)

The terms of competition

- 1) The competition will take place from 24th to 25th April 2010 at the premises of Gymnazium Nova Paka.
- 2) It is competition with international participation and violinists of all nations can take part in it.
- 3) All compositions will be performed by heart and without repeats.
- 4) There will be 3 juries (for 1st and 2nd category, for 3rd and 4th category, for 5th and 6th category).
- 5) The decision of the jury (Czech and foreign experts) is definitive and jury conferences are closed for public.
- 6) The organizer has the privilege to decide whether the competition will be broadcasted.
- 7) All rounds will take place in attendance of the public.
- 8) The results will be made public after the end of each round.
- 9) The participants of the competition have to perform in the possible evening concert if asked by organizers.
- 10) Participants will be awarded by diplomas for 1st place (gold medal, 2nd place (silver medal) and 3rd place (bronze medal), diplomas for the best performance of the compulsory compositions and certificates to remember participation in the competition. There will be absolute winner of the 14th Annual of Josef Muzika Violin Competition rewarded.

The terms of competition – attachment regarding the categories

Pupils and students of Art Schools, Private Art Schools and Conservatories compete in 6 categories, from 6 up to 18 years of age

I. – II. CATEGORY

FOR 1st CATEGORY 6-7 YEARS old (competitors born after 30. 6. 2003 – that means date of birth from 1.7.2003 – and younger) ONE-ROUND CONTEST

For 1st category arbitrary composition (max. 5 min.) is needed.

FOR 2nd CATEGORY 8-9 YEARS old (competitors born after 30. 6. 2001 – that means date of birth from 1.7.2001 – 30.6.2003) ONE-ROUND CONTEST WITH COMPULSORY COMPOSITION

For 2nd category arbitrary composition (max. 5 min.) is needed and **compulsory composition Jiří MATYS “Písničky” (Songs)**.

Both compositions (1st the arbitrary one and 2nd the compulsory one) shall be performed in sequence.

III. – IV. CATEGORY

FOR 3rd CATEGORY 10 – 11 YEARS old (competitors born after 30. 6. 1999 – that means date of birth from 1.7.1999 – 30.6.2001) TWO-ROUND CONTEST

FOR 4th CATEGORY 12 – 13 YEARS old (competitors born after 30. 6. 1997 – that means date of birth from 1.7.1997 – 30.6.1999) TWO-ROUND CONTEST

FOR THE 1st ROUND

For both categories romantic or postromantic composition is needed (for example Brahms – the Hungarian dance, Dvořák – Humoreska, Paganini – Sonatina, Mlynarski – Mazurek, Moszkowski – The Spanish dance) or a movement of violin concert by Rieding, Seitz, Accolay, Beriote, and so on.

Max. length 10 min.

FOR THE 2nd ROUND:

a) some part of baroque or classical composition (max. length 5 min.).

b) compulsory composition: **Bohuslav MARTINU „Colombína tančí” (COLOMBINA IS DANCING)** in arrangement by Antonín Moravec for violin and piano – the 3rd category

c) compulsory composition by **Vítězslav NOVÁK „A Note to the Scrap book“ („Lístek do památníku“)** – the 4th category

Max. length 10 min.

V. CATEGORY

FOR 5th CATEGORY 14 – 15 YEARS old (competitors born after 30. 6. 1995 – that means date of birth from 1.7.1995-30.6.1997) TWO ROUND CONTEST

FOR THE 1st ROUND

Masterly romantic or postromantic, or modern composition is needed, or at least a part of concert, for example by Čajkovskij, Dvořák, Laub, Ondříček, Sarasate, Vieuxtemps, Wieniawski, Schönberg, Szymanowski, Ysaye, and so on.

Max. length 15 min.

FOR THE 2nd ROUND

a) baroque or classical composition or a part of some concert (for example Bach, Bieber, Corelli, Händl, Leclair, Locatelli, Vejvanovský, Vitali, Vivaldi or Haydn, Mozart, Mysliveček, and so on).

b) compulsory composition by **Václav TROJAN** „SLAVÍKUV KONCERT“

Max length 15 min.

VI. CATEGORY

FOR 6th CATEGORY 16 – 18 YEARS old (competitors born after 30. 6. 1992 – that means date of birth from 1.7.1992–30.6.1995) TWO-ROUND CONTEST

FOR THE 1ST ROUND

The terms are the same as for the 5th category

Max length 15 min.

FOR THE 2nd ROUND

a) the same terms as for the 5th category

b) compulsory composition by **Leoš JANÁČEK** „BALADA“

Max length 15 min.
